- Explore Dublin's lively streets on a guided walking tour and enjoy a welcome dinner.
- Take a scenic boat ride to Devenish Island and wander among ancient monastic ruins.
- Marvel at the soaring Slieve League cliffs and hike through the wild landscapes of Glencolmille.
- Walk the trails of Glenveagh National Park and tour the elegant rooms and gardens of Glenveagh Castle.
- Enjoy tea and scones in the castle's charming tearoom overlooking lakes and mountains.
- Hike the dramatic coastal paths of Horn Head with sweeping Atlantic views and wildlife sightings
- Visit Grianán of Aileach, an ancient stone fort with panoramic vistas over the Inishowen Peninsula.
- Tour the historic Derry city walls on a guided walk and take in views of the River Foyle.
- Walk along the Causeway Coast Way, passing cliffs and beaches on the way to the Giant's Causeway.
- Climb over the famous basalt columns of the Giant's Causeway, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Explore the medieval ruins of Dunluce Castle perched high above the ocean.
- Stroll the medieval streets of Carlingford and enjoy fresh seafood in this pretty little town.
