Explore Ireland's southwest with scenic walks through Beara, Killarney, and Dingle—paired with visits to charming towns, gardens, and historic sites.



ACTIVITY LEVEL

Designed for active travelers, with up to 5 hours of scenic walking daily at a comfortable pace, covering 2–6 miles over well-maintained paths and hill trails. Terrain is generally gentle, with occasional muddy sections and ascents up to 1,500 feet.

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What You'll Do and See

- Explore Dublin's historic streets on a guided walking tour before a welcome dinner with your group.
- Wander among the medieval ruins at the Rock of Cashel as you learn about Ireland's storied past.
- Take a relaxed hike near Glengarriff, surrounded by lush woodlands and panoramic views of Bantry Bay.
- Ride a boat to Garnish Island and stroll through its tranquil Italianate gardens and exotic plant collections
- Embark on a scenic hike through the Beara Peninsula, taking in rugged hills, dramatic cliffs, and serene lakes.
- Experience rural traditions at Molly Gullivan's Cottage and try turf cutting and traditional breadmaking.
- Discover the breathtaking landscapes of Killarney National Park, including a boat trip on Lough Leane and a woodland hike.
- Tour the elegant rooms and gardens of Muckross House, a grand Victorian mansion in Killarney.
- Watch for seabirds and dolphins as you walk along the Atlantic coastline at Inch Strand.
- Hike the dramatic cliffs and green hills of Slea Head, with views of the Blasket Islands on the horizon.
- Visit the Blasket Centre to learn about the unique culture and literary legacy of the Blasket Islanders.
- Stroll the charming streets of Adare Village, browse local boutiques, and enjoy a group lunch.
